Drug Claim

For increased rate of weight gain; control of bacterial pneumonia associated with shipping fever complex caused by Pasteurella spp. susceptible to chlortetracycline and for control of active infection of anaplasmosis caused by Anaplasma marginale susceptible to chlortetracycline in pasture cattle (under 700 lbs, slaughter, stocker, feeder cattle and dairy and beef replacement heifers).

Feeding Directions:

For control of bacterial pneumonia and increased weight gain: Thorougly mix 500 lbs. of **SWEETLIX**^{*} A + B Stocker Mineral with 1,500 lbs. of nonmedicated feed. Feed one pound of this medicated mixture to provide 350 mg CTC and 180 mg lasalocid per head per day. Cattle should recieve 350 mg CTC and not less than 60 mg nor more than 300 mg lasalocid per head per day for the stated drug claims. For control of anaplasmosis and inmproved weight gain in cattle less than 700 lbs.: Thorougly mix 500 lbs. of **SWEETLIX**[®] **A** + **B** Stocker Mineral with 1,500 lbs. of nonmedicated feed. Feed one pound of this medicated mixture to provide 350 mg CTC and 180 mg lasalocid per head per day. Cattle should recieve 350 mg CTC and not less than 60 mg nor more than 300 mg lasalocid per head per day for the stated drug claims.

WARNING: A withdrawal period has not been established for this product in preruminating cattle. Do not use in calves to be processed for veal.

CAUTION: Use as directed. The safety of lasalocid for use in unapproved species has not been established. Do not allow horses or other equines access to feeds containing lasalocid as ingestion may be fatal. Consumption of selenium should not exceed 3 mg per head per day. Four (4) ounces of this product provides 3 mg selenium.

WARNING: This product, which contains added copper, should not be fed to sheep or any species with a low tolerance to supplemental copper.
